
Faith, Food, & Fun: Earth Day

Grace Renovation Update

Many thanks to our Grace volunteer renovation work team, most recently focused on completing our transformation to LED lighting and replacing aging and sagging ceiling tiles around the church. At this point, all of our classrooms and gathering spaces have had fluorescent lights replaced with LEDs,



saving substantial cost over the long term and greatly reducing manpower requirements for replacing burned out bulbs. These efforts, by reducing energy requirements, directly contribute to NetZero goals of the Northern Illinois Conference and our own Grace Church and Society Committee to have net zero hydrocarbon emissions by Y2030.

Ceiling tile replacement has seen steady progress over the last couple of years, sprucing up our meeting and class rooms around the church. Final replacements were completed in March 2024. This effort has required a reliable work force with many hands to mount the ladders, jostle the old tiles out (braving years of dust and "whatever"!), cut tiles to fit, and carefully get them emplaced. This is dusty, messy work, so it's been particularly notable that the cleanup effort at the end of each day's work has been impeccable! Special thanks for our most recent effort goes out to Gregg Chalecki, Larry Hartman, Nick Hoyle, Bob Schmitt, and Ron Wills.

Saving the Earth from Foam

As part of our environmental efforts for the past few years, Church & Society's "Green Team" have been collecting Styrofoam in the church vestibule, sorting it, and taking it to Dart in Aurora for recycling. Recently we learned that it would be far better not to use it at all. To that end, we have halted our Styrofoam collection and we ask that people stop leaving it at church.

Styrofoam is made from styrene, a human carcinogen according to the World Health Organization. Packaging Styrofoam is coated with flame-retardants which are also carcinogens. Recycling is limited and generates single use products. Burning Styrofoam generates carcinogens. Styrofoam is not compostable nor is it biodegradable—but it does break down, into smaller and smaller pieces, eventually becoming < 5 mm, a "polystyrene microplastic." There are over 3,000 studies detailing the adverse effects of these to human health. Finally, plastic is a huge problem in the ocean, especially for the many sea creatures who consume the plastic particles. And when we consume seafood, we too consume plastic. In conclusion, Styrofoam is both a health hazard and a huge source of global pollution. It is best to avoid using it at all.

As of January 1, 2025, Styrofoam (labelled as #6 for recycling) used for food containers will be banned by Illinois for state agencies. Many European countries already ban polystyrenes.

What can we do? One can take containers from home to restaurants for leftovers. We can write our legislators to support legislation against Styrofoam use. And we can avoid single-use plastics whenever possible. We applaud your concern for the environment. Please join us in advocating for change with regard to Styrofoam use!



Who are Grace Gardeners? Maybe YOU!

We are looking for a few more folks to join our crew. Our goal: keep the church grounds attractive.

How do we work? The landscaping beds on the property are divvied into sections. Gardeners take responsibility for one or more sections, and work at the time and pace of their choosing. Most beds are already planted with shrubs and perennials. We assist with keeping them weeded and trimming off dead material. Professional landscapers B&B do the bush trimming, Preen and mulch applications, and spring cleanup. Occasionally, we gardeners divide and transplant perennials, but most of our work is not strenuous. We have varying levels of experience, so you needn't be an expert!


